Milltown Public Library was selected in round two of Libraries Transforming Communities: Accessible Small and Rural Communities, an American Library Association (ALA) initiative that provides community engagement and accessibility resources to small and rural libraries to help them better serve people with disabilities.

The library received a \$10,000 grant that will help the library assist adults who are visually impaired.

The grant funded an increase in our large print books to include 14 new titles every month. In addition, the grant funded the addition of 62 e-audio books and 53 e-books to the Wisconsin Digital Library collection with Libby.

The library will host a Technology program on September 17 @ 2 PM to patrons with visual impairments to demonstrate many of the free tools available on their existing smart phones.

In addition, local agencies were contacted to provide flyers for our display of the available resources in our area.

The library is committed to continuous improvement; we welcome all feedback and suggestions.
